

GBGB PROTEST GUIDELINES

PLEASE READ IN FULL

THESE GUIDELINES ARE PRIMARILY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOURSELF AND THOSE AROUND YOU, AND TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGE TO THE ANTI RACING MOVEMENT AS A WHOLE.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT EMOTIONS CAN RUN HIGH AT PROTESTS , BUT WE ASK THAT YOU PLEASE RESPECT THE ORGANISERS AND NUMEROUS CAMPAIGN GROUPS , WHO'S INTEGRITY MAY DEPEND ON YOUR ACTIONS AT A PROTEST.

Please read the following carefully;

Important; Please do NOT obstruct the road at any time. Standing in the way of traffic is a safety hazard and an offence.

There will be two areas - One area will be designated for people with noisy instruments and another for those who are without. This will hopefully contain the noise and prevent noise sensitive protesters from being put off future protests.

Please do NOT bring dogs

We advise that you do not bring children who may be frightened from the noise or crowds - Any children should be closely accompanied by an adult at all times throughout the protest.

Please do not bring anything that may resemble a weapon.

Please do not throw any missiles, regardless of how harmless you think

they are.

Please avoid bringing umbrellas or prams, as this will not be safe in a confined area with such large volume of people. It may also aggravate other protesters.

Please do NOT shout obscenities. This reflects badly on the movement and can be seen as provocation in some situations, it can also be classed as a criminal offence.

If you have any questions or problems, please approach a steward. Stewards can be recognised by their printed 'Caged Steward' yellow high vis vests and are there to help keep the protest well organised and safe.

There 'may' be a police presence, due to the volume of protesters being in close proximity to the road, and on such narrow pathways. Barriers 'may' be used to keep people away from the road area. If this is so, please stay behind the barriers at all times.

If the police do attend, they will not be there to prevent your freedom of speech, they simply have a responsibility to keep people safe.

Caged First Aiders will be present for attending to any minor injuries. First Aiders will be recognisable by their 'printed' high visibility jackets.

In the event of an emergency first dial 999 and then notify stewards.

Caged Nationwide stewards will hand out placards at the beginning of the protest.

We have around 90 lightweight placards that people are free to hold, but you are welcome to bring your own placards if preferred. We also

will provide leaflets for people to hand out to any interested members of the public.

2 Caged members will have megaphones, unfortunately these particular megaphones cannot be used by other members of the protest incase of any damage.

Protesters are welcome to bring their own megaphones, air horns etc
